#### This Month's News from the Editor.

This month's talk night Ivan Randall and Michael Smith will be discussing one of the most popular research sites, Ancestry.com.

If you have not considered utilising a computer program to record your family history research before, might I suggest that you contact a Committee member who will point you into the right direction. Remember that up-to-date versions of both Legacy and Family Tree Maker programs are available from the ANDFHG clubrooms at comparable prices.

The ANDFHG Committee has recently procured a pre paid mobile telephone, so that members and other enquirers are able to contact a Committee member, for advice, help or making a booking for research assistance. Currently Margaret Flaiban, our effortless working Secretary, is the major contact. Full details appear elsewhere in this newssheet. Please observe the hours that this service is available.

We have also purchased an A3 size Laminator, which will enable those precious documents or posters to be fully protected from wear and tear, by having them laminated. 
